It is as viable as its Alliance contemporary, with its Endurance being very Tanking in World of Warcraft: Classic requires strategy, with War Stomp being a useful ability due to its flexibility. Nature Resistance also provides additional survivability in specific situations. Besides their Quickness, Night Elf Druids benefit from Shadowmeld, which enhances the effectiveness of Prowl. In choosing a profession, Herbalism is a great option when combined with Alchemy, allowing for self-sufficiency. Engineering is widely used and beneficial in both PvP and PvE. As alchemists can create flasks and powerful potions, Druids are ideal for this profession. The Classic Profession tier list offers a variety of choices, from crafting armour to farming materials.
