CHECKLIST FOR ENROLLMENT OF STUDENTS GRADES K-12

The following documents are required to register. Please review the list below and detailed descriptions to ensure that you have the proper documentation. Students will not be enrolled without the appropriate items.

	☐ Three proofs of Broward County residence. All bills/statements must be current (30 days or less) and in the name of the		
	parent/legal guardian. See list of acceptable documentation below. Original Health and Immunization Forms. Expired forms will not be accepted. Students entering Kindergarten must have		
	immunizations and health exam completed before entering school. Students entering 7th grade must have Tdap vaccine.		
	Test scores, e.g., SAT, FSA. Required if student is entering a Pembroke Pines Charter School for the first time. Grades 1-12 Military: Documentation of active duty, i.e., Statement of Service or Standard Travel Order and valid military photo identification. Documentation must show "dates of service".		
	Volunteer Service: All parents must complete a minimum of 30 hours per school year.

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SCHOOL RECORDS/PROOF OF GRADE LEVEL

Latest report card and/or transcript. Final quarter report card must show promotion to next grade level. Student will not be registered without this documentation in grades 1-12.
Test scores, e.g. SAT, FSA, etc. Required if student is entering a Pembroke Pines Charter School for the first time.
Children who will be 6 years old on or before September 1st, of the school year and who have been enrolled in a public school shall be eligible for admission to first grade. Students who have completed kindergarten in a private school AND who are 6 years old on or before September of the current school year, shall be eligible for admission to first grade. A report card from the private school stating satisfactory completion of kindergarten must be presented at time of registration
MEDICAL AND IMMUNIZATION RECORDS (Must be provided at time of registration)
To begin the registration process, please bring the most recent health forms (medical exam/immunizations) to registration even if the shots are incomplete or expired. If the child is attending a pre-school, then a copy can be requested from the current school prior to registration. The updated forms from a health care provider must be provided before the first day of school.
Florida law requires that, prior to a child's attendance in a public school in PreK-12 grade; parents must provide the following immunization/medical examination records:
Medical Examination:
Florida School Entry Health/Medical Exam (Form DH 3040). Students, grades K-12, entering Florida schools for the first time must present evidence of a medical examination performed within the 12 months prior to their initial enrollment.
Immunizations: (One of the following)
Florida Certificate of Immunization (Completed) (Form DH 680)
Florida Certificate of Immunization TEMPORARY exemption (Form DH 680 Part B) with physician signature and expiration date in Part B is acceptable if the child is in the process of completing the required number of immunizations.
Religious exemption (Form 681)
Medical exemption (Form DH680 Part C)
