Students are randomly placed in their house, they may or may not be with a family member.





FALL PROGRAM ON THE EUCHARIST:

This year we are going to think about the gift of the Eucharist. We will be meeting in small groups over the course of five weeks in the fall starting the week of Sunday Oct. 8th and going through the week that will start on Sunday Nov. 5th.

Week beginning Oct. 8th: Why Do Catholics Celebrate the Mass?

Week beginning Oct. 15th: The Early Christians Believed in the Real Presence

Week beginning Oct. 22nd: Why are Catholics asked to go to Mass on Sundays and Holy Days / Is the Mass we celebrate today the same as in the Ancient Church?

Week beginning Oct. 29th: A Walk Through the Mass

Week beginning Nov. 5th: The Passover and the Exodus and the Mass / The Eucharistic Miracle in Buenos Aires in 1996


