Above: Sometimes nature just needs a helping hand. To help the headwaters of the mighty Colorado River, we built beaver dam analogs along Trail Creek on the Gunnison National Forest. This type of low-tech, process-based restoration offers a simple way to support this important ecosystem.

Right: Near Hope, Alaska, Resurrection Creek has welcomed salmon back to its waters. After decades of mining altered the landscape, the NFF has worked closely with the Chugach National Forest and local partners to restore this breathtaking waterway.

Below: Prescribed burning on the Tahoe National Forest, where fire has always been part of the natural landscape, and many forests have adapted to and need fire to remain healthy. While high-severity wildfires pose extreme risk to forest ecosystems, low to moderate-intensity fires can play a key role in keeping those same ecosystems healthy by reducing understory density and returning nutrients to the soil.

As wildfires continue to grow in intensity, we know they don't respect land boundaries. In Central Colorado, we are utilizing a unique funding model to implement wildfire mitigation projects on public and private lands. The Upper Arkansas Forest Fund supports a healthy landscape beyond the surrounding National Forest.





s more people visit and enjoy National A Forests, we're ensuring that these forests can support recreation opportunities for all. With the help of our donors and partners, we're installing new signage, building additional restroom facilities, restoring damaged campgrounds, and more.

This cabin is just one of many slated to be built and renovated across Alaska's National Forests in what is the single largest expansion of public use cabins in Alaska in over 50 years.

Construction wrapped up in the fall of 2023 on seven new segments of boardwalk that traverse through meadows and marshy areas on this popular hike. Visitors can marvel at the views of Mt. Hood from many platforms along the boardwalk, which was also constructed wider than previous boardwalks for improved accessibility.

The Wood for Life program provided critical firewood for Indigenous communities, including the Navajo Nation.








We planted 586,000 trees on Michigan's Huron-Manistee National Forest to provide habitat for the Endangered Kirtland's Warbler.
